

The **Wintonbury Land Trust** is a tax-exempt, non-profit corporation established in 1982 to preserve the natural environmental resources so important to the quality of life in Bloomfield. At present, the Wintonbury Land Trust holds and manages over 200 acres principally in the Town of Bloomfield, as well as Windsor, West Hartford and Simsbury.

All of the current land holdings were donated. The Wintonbury Land Trust is now tasked with raising funds so it can preserve two important properties: a 10-acre urban farm and 13 acres of grassland next to Penwood State Park.
